Response to the initial consultation

An initial public consultation was held between 9 November and 7 December 2018. Approximately 180 people attended the consultation events over the two days. 151 feedback forms were completed and additional responses were received from parish councils and other organisations.




180 people attended the drop-in events

The results of the initial consultation showed that there was general support for the westbound and eastbound climbing lanes to the south-west of Bothel and the improved A595 / A591 junction.

Following the initial consultation, the designs have been developed to respond to the feedback received:

The 1 metre strips either side of the carriageway have been removed.

It is not proposed to close any side roads within Bothel.

a bypass option be reconsidered A bypass was one of a number of options identified. When assessed it offered low value for money and therefore it would not be possible to secure funding. A non-technical summary of the option appraisal can be found at:

the speed limit on the A595 as it passes Bothel should be reduced We have started to investigate a lower speed limit. Any changes to speed limits needs to follow a statutory process which could take up to 9 months.

improvements are required at other junctions such as the Greyhound Inn Junction

The scheme now includes improvements at the Greyhound Inn / Torpenhow Junction. This includes improved visibility and right turn lanes in each direction. The scheme proposals would significantly improve visibility from other side road junctions.
